
### Conflicts Resolution and Trauma Healing

The Catholic Health Training Institute (CHTI), also known as Catholic Health Science Institute or CHSI) recently organized a training session for nursing and midwifery students focused on conflict resolution and trauma healing. The program was facilitated by Sr. Christin of the Medical Missionaries of Mary (MMM). This initiative aimed to foster reconciliation, build social cohesion, and equip the next generation with the tools to break the cycle of violence. As a neutral and trusted institution, the CHTI is uniquely positioned to bring together individuals from diverse and often antagonistic backgrounds, encouraging intergroup collaboration and peaceful dialogue in a divided society. By integrating peace education and trauma healing into the curriculum, these students are being trained not only as healthcare professionals but as active agents of peace.
